

# Curlew Island is growing and moving

The vegetated sandbank informally known as Curlew Island in the middle of the Broadwater off Marine Parade in Labrador is growing in length, width and area, and also moving west.

The sandbanks were drawn at different tide levels so comparison of the sandbank extents is unreliable.
